These prices are effective as of October 12, 2019, but are subject to change without notice.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason, in writing, on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

"Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or part, by or on behalf of the decedent."

### **MINIMUM SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF**

This fee is for our basic services and will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burial, and forwarding or receiving remains). This fee includes the following:

- Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call
- Arrangement Conference
- Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased
- Clerical assistance in the completion of various forms and permits associated with a funeral
- Also covers overhead, including facility maintenance, equipment and inventory costs, insurance and administration expenses, and government compliance

### **PREPARATION OF THE BODY**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

### **FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME**

This charge includes transfer of remains from the place of death, minimum service of staff, necessary authorizations, embalming, use of preparation room, and transportation to local airport or other place of shipment within a 50-mile radius. Exclude shipping container, shipping and county charge). This charge does not include visitation or ceremonies. This charge applies to shipment within the continental U.S. only.

Includes minimum services of staff, transportation from local airport or other shipping destination, and transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory. This charge includes viewing and separate reception area and church funeral ceremonies or our chapel facilities with reception area.

### **DIRECT CREMATION**

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are alternative containers and other cremation containers, including containers made of wood, containers made of fiberboard and containers made of other composite materials. We offer a selection of cremation oriented caskets.

Our charges for direct cremation (without ceremony) include transfer of remains from the place of death, transportation to the crematory, refrigeration, minimum services of staff and the crematory fee.

### Payment Policy

In order to serve all clients fairly and to prevent misunderstandings, Lighthouse Memorials & Receptions have established a uniform payment policy.

It is customary to pay charges at the conclusion of the arrangement conference with your director.

To confirm scheduled events, payment of charges in full is required by the morning of the day before the first viewing or service, or no more than one week after the arrangement conference, whichever occurs first. Acceptable forms of payment are: check, cash, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover, funeral trust accounts and life insurance policies. A Credit Card Service fee will be added to the invoice when choosing that method of payment. Life insurance\* policies may be accepted under the following conditions:

1. The policy is in force and assignable
2. The policy is an individual policy and not a group policy
3. That no loans have been taken out on the policy
4. The original policy is surrendered
5. That the beneficiary or beneficiaries all sign all necessary documents
6. The insurance company provides the mortuary with written assurance that they will pay the funeral home
7. The insurance company conveys assurance that there are enough funds in the insurance to pay for the contracted arrangements
8. That all of the above be accomplished three (3) working days prior to the morning before the first event: viewing, service or scheduling a cremation

Third party checks, future payments from estate funds and credit cards in the name of the decedent will not be accepted

Should a credit balance result from adjustments to the contract a refund will be issued after the 15th of the month following the month in which services were held to allow time for processing of any billing adjustments received from outside service providers.

\*There will be a \$150.00 processing fee per policy for insurance policy assignments (this does not apply to Lighthouse Memorial & Receptions funeral insurance plans). Policies under two years old are generally contestable and may not be accepted. Policies must be non-contestable, assignable and insurance company confirmation of beneficiary must be obtained before mortuary can accept such policies.
